Articles and Research Papers:

Full-length research paper should not exceed 4000 words including tables and references. or about 10 typewritten double-spaced 8 ½ x11 with 30 or less lines in a page (A4. Size) sheets, with wide-left hand margins) Subject matter should be organized under suitable headings and subheadings such as Structured Abstract. Introduction. Content-based Review of earlier Research, Study relevance. Methods. Results, Discussion, Acknowledgements and References, Footnotes should be avoided and their contents incorporated in the text while references go to the first page should contain.

- (a) Title and subtitle of the paper
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Papers are published in **ENGLISH** The editors reserve the right to suggest/make any necessary editorial changes. The number of authors has to be limited to three and all have to sign the copyright release form. Name and mailing addresses of all authors should be included.

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The manuscript both hard and soft copy should be sent by post. Electronic copies may also be e-mailed to the Editor of Journal The author (s)should retain a complete copy of the manuscript; the original manuscript cannot be returned. Prior to publication, the author (s)must guarantee:(1) that the article has not been previously published: (2) that it is not being considered for publication elsewhere: and (3)that it has been submitted with the full knowledge and approval of the funding agency in case it is the part of their project work. Submission of multi-authored manuscripts implies the consent of each of the authors. All authors must sign the Author (s) Guarantee Form accompanying the transmittal letter. The article's principal author is responsible for ensuring that all the necessary forms are signed and returned.

The Structure of the Research Paper:

The paper should be described. Under the following major headings:

Structured abstract is required for all research papers. The structured abstract, limited to 150 words, should contain features under objectives; method; limitations; analysis and conclusion.

Objective:- should reflect the purpose of the study, that is, the hypothesis that is being tested

Method:- should include the setting for the study, the subject (number and type), the treatment or intervention, the sample. Tools etc and the type of statistical analysis.

Limitations:- should explain the universe of the study, its methodological limitations and the uncovered areas concerned.

Result:- section includes the outcome of the study, major findings with suitable interpretations and analysis.

Conclusion:- The Conclusion should clearly state the significance of the results, issues emerged and solutions suggested based on the study, in case relevant and areas of further research concerned.

Acknowledgements:- Personal acknowledgements will be limited to appropriate professional support received in developing the paper.

References:- References should be selective and should in general be limited to the last decade. In case of short quotations, they can be put within the text with inverted commas (“”); but long quotations should be placed in single spaced paragraphs. They must be numbered and listed as they are cited in the article/research papers;
